The event is organized in the framework of "Young Citizens of Armenia" /"YCA"/project in collaboration with the CAUCULT Caucasus Cultural Initiatives Network project. The aim of the project is to create a dialogue between different members of society and learn about their lifestyle.

In the open-air library we will host real people instead of books, people who have undergone different paths in their life. They will speak about their life stories. Reading will take place in the form of conversation. The participants can ask their questions and listen to the stories of the “books”.
